•	The process consultants are obliged to maintain a neutral position vis-à-vis the criminal proceedings. In particular, their activities must neither result in the witness being influenced nor have any impact on the witness statement. One essential principle of psychologocial process support is thus the separation of counselling and assistance .						
•	The process consultants are not involved in the elucidation of the facts underlying the criminal proceedings (the "crime"). Rather, they are required to not hold any discussions with the casualties in relation to the actual crime .						
•	Psychosocial process support cannot replace either a therapeutic treatment or psychological consultation . If there is any need for any such farther-reaching offers for as sistance and counselling, however, the process consultants may help in the search for suitable professional institutions.						
•	Finally, the responsibilities of the process consultants do not include the task of providing the casualties with advice on legal possibilities for action or to safeguard their leginterests . For these purposes, the party concerned must contact a lawyer or solicitor required.
